

Chapter-1

1.0. Introduction

Usually, a long history of relentless service and sacrifice is involved in any creative or gigantic task. The history often comes to light or remains hidden for long. Those who devote themselves to making such historical advancements do those just out of their curiosity or simply because they feel enthusiastic to do so. In fact, behind the establishment and progress of today's Lalmatia Mohila College, the true sacrifice and enthusiasm of a few benevolent people worked as an impetus. The board of directors of the then 'Cooperative Housing Society' along with a few benevolent social activists dedicated to education took the initiative to establish a college. And as part of that initiative, an ad-hoc committee was formed. The honorable and proud members of that committee were—

The magnificently, systematically and admirably designed Lalmatia Mohila College was established on 1 August 1966 on a land whose area was 14,337.50 square ct. meter. With its enriched tradition and splendor, the institution is situated just the opposite of National Parliament Bhabon in the heart of Dhaka, the capital city of Bangladesh. The amount of land was allotted to the college as lease for 99 years on 14 October 1978 according to a letter (reference no. 3809) by the then deputy commissioner (settlement) under the Ministry of Public Works and Urban Development. The college started its academic activities with science and humanities group in 1st July 1966 and commerce group in 1st July 1969. Since its establishment the college has been doing extraordinary performance in HSC and within a short period of time has earned fame as a renowned HSC college in the country. The college earned the title of 'the best HSC college in Dhaka city' in 1991 awarded by the then Ministry of Education.

Afterwards through its successful opening of Honors and Masters Course in 1993-94, the college started expanding its academic affairs. In the long journey at a crucial and critical time of the college, Advocate Jahangir Kabir Nanok, the current Presidium member of Awami League was entrusted with the responsibility of chairman of the governing body. And the governing body recommended Professor Dr. Md. Rafiqul Islam as principal of the college, a BCS education cadre and the Ministry of Education effected his appointment as deputation since 12 July 2012. Having planned a special DPP in 2013 and with the funding of the government, three residential hostel buildings accommodating 972 seats, a modern auditorium, and a multistoried academic building were built by the present governing body and administration. Also, the BBA administration building, a modern archway gate, a guardians' shed, 13 online booths, a bank booth and a one-stop service center were built during the tenure of this administration. Besides, a deep tube-well inside a safe place of the campus to ensure pure drinking water for the students has been installed. All administrative, academic and financial services have been under automation by Wi-Fi connectivity and self-software program. To ensure constant monitoring and flawless security of the college IP cameras have been

installed in different places. Also, modern ICT lab and 23 multimedia class rooms have been established. And the science labs and all wash rooms have been modernized and rebuilt.

Lalmatia Mohila College affiliated by National University, Gazipur, Bangladesh is currently imparting education in 19 subjects in Honors level and 17 subjects in Masters Level. The college accommodates almost 8700 students and the number of teachers is altogether 141 including principal, vice-principal and 14 visiting teachers. The college also contains 100 support staff including 3rd and 4th class workers, officers and officials. Along with doing outstanding performances in academic field, the students are performing their best in sports, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities and achieving prestigious positions in national level competitions. The college keeps on having an enviable track record in building knowledgeable, wise, and morally responsible citizens. In line with its success like before, this institution in terms of contributing to women's education tremendously across Bangladesh, has become able to include itself in 'one of the best women's colleges in Bangladesh' and also 'one of the pre-model colleges' recognized by National University.

The students of Lalmatia Mohila College are not only doing outstanding performance in academic sector but also doing the same in extracurricular activities and are achieving prizes in national level. The students' best performance is not only recognized in education but also in sports, cultural activities, debate competitions, scientific research, rover and ranging activities etc. and the students who can prove their merit in all these sectors are offered lucrative compensation packages like yearly half free, and full free tuition fee waiver. Besides, these students are offered opportunities of participating in free English Language Learning Training Program, Enhancement of Computer Literacy and other soft skills through which they can be self-reliant and self-confident to cope with the challenges of life ahead. Especially Lalmatia Mohila College is an enviable example of extending a helping hand to those who are registered orphans of SOS Children's home and of other orphanages through granting full-free tuition fee waiver and helping them become engaged in part-time jobs created in 'Students' Welfare Corner' which has been established recently within the college campus. Furthermore, to observe the birth centenary of the father of the nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman 'Mujib Creative Lab' has been established recently in which students can avail the opportunities of learning Free-lancing and other IT-based training facilities with free of cost.

Lalmatia Mohila College is a female based college. Only Female students can admit in this institution.


